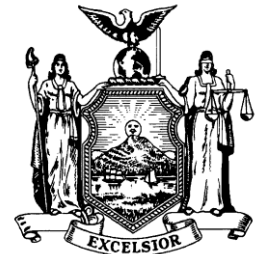

## Chapter 122. Fees and Fines

### Chapter 85, Building Code Administration – Operating Permit Fees

- A. Inspection applications shall be processed by the Fire Inspector in compliance with the NYS Uniform Fire Code.
- B. Owners /Tenants shall register annually with the Fire Inspector within 30 days of notice. Failure to comply may result in legal action and penalty of \$250.00.
- C. Owners/Tenants of property, office space, unit, or multi-family, shall pay to the Town of Wappinger the annual fee determined by gross floor area of the use as follows:

#### (3) Operating Permit Fees

- [a] Annual fee for operating Permits for areas of public assembly and nonresidential uses requiring operating permits: **(NOT FOR MULTI FAMILY BUILDINGS. SEE BELOW FOR SEPARATE FEE SCHEDULE)**

1 to 999 square feet	\$100
1,000 to 2,999 square feet	\$150
3,000 to 5,999 square feet	\$250
6,000 to 11,999 square feet	\$300
12,000 to 24,000 square feet	\$500
Above 24,000 square feet	\$500 plus \$25 for each 1,000 square feet above 24,000.
Common Area of Building	\$175

[b] **Multiple Family dwellings:**

- [i] Three to 10 units: \$200 per year.
- [ii] Eleven to 50 units: \$275 per year.
- [iii] More than 50 units: \$350 per year.
- [iv] Multiple dwelling common area: \$175 per year.

- [c] Alarm for nonresidential occupancies: \$150 per year.

- A. The payment of the above fees shall be the responsibility of the occupant of the premises, except that the fee for commercial common area shall be the responsibility of the property owner. Fees are subject to change from time to time upon adoption of an updated ordinance or the discovery of additional square footage in a structure or separate structure(s) that were not previously identified.
- B. Failure to pay operational or assembly fees. It shall be unlawful to refuse or fail to pay the operational or assembly fee after being given notice to do so per the established fee schedule.
