

ANNUAL CENTER LICENSE

Welcome to the Town Recycle Center and Transfer Station from the Wappinger Town Clerk's Office & Town Highway Department. We at the Town Clerk's office are once again offering the option to purchase your annual Recycle Center License by mail or at the Clerk's Office at Town Hall - 20 Middlebush Road, Wappingers Falls, NY 12590. If you choose to purchase by mail, simply send us:

A) COPY OF YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE

Note: If your Drivers License contains a PO Box # you must send in addition, a copy of your electric/cable bill, or proof of Town of Wappinger residency - other than your tax receipt - as the Center is for residents, NOT land-lords.

B) COPY OF EACH CAR'S REGISTRATION

Note: There is a 2 car limit and the license MUST match the registration.

C) CASH, CREDIT CARD, OR CHECK

made payable to the "Town of Wappinger" for one of the following amounts:

D) The town board has determined that double axle trailers will no longer be allowed and that single axle trailers will be given a one time non renewable booklet of 8 tickets good for only the 2026 calendar year.

The cost for seniors:

\$75 if born in 1965 or later, and

\$45 if born in 1964 or earlier.

Recycle Center Rules

- Only vehicles registered to a town 'resident' are licensed to use the center.
- Contractors are not licensed to use the center for their businesses. Businesses are not residents.
- Landlords living outside the Town are not residents.
- Each Household is entitled to 2 vehicles both of which are registered under the household address. Should a resident with an annual pass need a larger vehicle to haul, then they will need to purchase an Alternate Vehicle pass for \$20.
- A license to use the recycling center is a grant of permission to use the recycling center for non-commercial use. Those persons using the recycling center for commercial purposes shall have their license revoked and shall not be eligible to reapply for a period of 5 years following a revocation of a license.

**NO BOX TRUCKS ALLOWED

How Much Is It?

\$75.00 Annual License - Limited to two cars per household

\$45.00 Annual License - Senior Discount: For residents 60 yrs+, limited to two cars per household

\$20.00 - Alternate Vehicle: one time use Alternative Vehicle pass

\$35.00 - Single Use License: One time use pass to the Center. NOT for full day

\$25 - Single Axle Trailer
- 8 Passes/YR: Excluding Household Garbage

FREE - Residential garbage
(Limit TWO bags per day)

E-Waste - Any electronic device, from large TVs and refrigerators to small mobile phones, printers, and even cables.



Glass - Jars and bottles of any size and color



Metal - Aluminum cans & foil, metal cans/jar lids, empty aerosol cans



Plastic - Food/beverage containers, empty cleaning containers, juice cartons



Paper - All non glossy print paper, cardboard, cartons, mail/envelopes

With immediate effect,
the following guidelines are in place:

1. A valid Scannable Vehicle Registration is now mandatory for town residents to obtain a recycling center pass. This applies specifically to vehicles registered to a Town of Wappinger address.
2. In the event that the scan code is obstructed, the driver's license must be presented, and it must match the address on the vehicle registration.
3. No exceptions will be made for unregistered, expired vehicles, or flagged residences.
4. Trailers registered out of state are allowed only if an annual license for the specific vehicle is possessed. All other trailers must be registered with the resident's Town of Wappinger address.
5. P.O. Boxes are acceptable only if proof of residence is provided. Such proof can be established through a driver's license with the resident's town street listed or by presenting documentation using the seven-point system, such as a cable bill, utility bill, or acknowledgement of voter registration in our system.

These measures are implemented to ensure that the recycling center is utilized exclusively by residents, discouraging commercial or out-of-town use. Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines is greatly appreciated and will help prevent the misuse of town services.
