- The Saratoga Springs History Museum is located inside the historic Canfield Casino. The museum's collection focuses on the cultural history of Saratoga Springs.
- Celebrate America's 250th Birthday with a tour of the NY Military Museum. Former 1889 armory displaying 10,000+ uniforms, weapons & art from the Civil War to the present.
- The historic downtown shopping district of Saratoga Springs offers lovely boutiques and quaint shops tucked among wonderful eateries and cafes. There are only a couple of the typical 'chain stores', making the downtown Saratoga area a delightful and unique place to spend time.
- The Wishing Well is an award-winning restaurant in Gansevoort, serving the region's finest selection of premium steaks, live lobsters, fresh seafood, and wines. Stone fireplaces, a piano bar, and attentive service are hallmarks of this dining spot. The celebrated Wishing Well Restaurant has been home to friends and guests since 1936.
- Dining at Brookmere is more than just a meal—it's a refined culinary journey at the Regent Restaurant & Bar, our chef-driven, regionally-inspired French brasserie in Saratoga Springs. Indulge in premium cuts, farm-fresh vegetables, and an expertly curated wine list.
- The first brew pub for Druthers Brewing Company, was constructed in 2012 in the heart of the Broadway Historic District. The brew pub sits about 120 feet off of Broadway; tucked away behind a hand-crafted iron gate and a pretty sweet beer garden. When you walk in, don't forget to look up!
