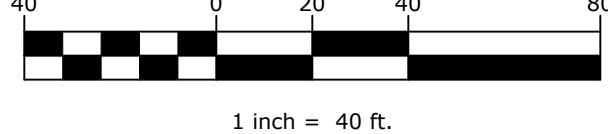
1. ALL WORK TO BE PERFORMED TO THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE TOWN OF WAPPINGERS FALLS.
2. ALL TOPSOIL, ROOTS, STUMPS AND OTHER DELETERIOUS MATERIAL SHALL BE REMOVED FROM ALL CONSTRUCTION AREAS.
3. ALL FILL FOR POND CONSTRUCTION, BELOW BUILDINGS AND PAVEMENT TO BE COMPACTED TO 95% OF MAXIMUM DRY DENSITY AS DETERMINED BY MODIFIED PROCTOR COMPACTION TEST ASTM D1557.
4. CELLAR, ROOF AND FOOTING DRAINS SHALL CONNECT TO THE STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM OR OTHER FREE-FLOWING OUTLET AT A MINIMUM SLOPE OF 0.5%. FOOTING DRAIN SHALL BE INSTALLED BENEATH BOTTOM OF FOOTING.
5. COMPLETION OF GRADING AND BASIN, BERMS AFTER OCTOBER 15 SHALL REQUIRE MULCHING AND ANCHORING IN ACCORDANCE WITH NOTES ENTITLED "EROSION & SEDIMENT CONTROL".
6. ALL SLOPES IN EXCESS OF 3H:1V SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITH LOCALLY AVAILABLE GLACIAL TILL. THE EMBANKMENT FILL SHALL BE PLACED IN SIX-INCHTHICK LIFTS. EACH LIFT SHALL BE PLACED AND COMPACTED TO 95% OF MAXIMUM DRY DENSITY AS DETERMINED BY MODIFIED PROCTOR COMPACTION TEST ASTM D1557.
7. CONSTRUCT POND EMBANKMENT WITH LOCALLY AVAILABLE GLACIAL TILL WITH 3H:1V SIDE SLOPES OR AS NOTED ON PLAN. THE EMBANKMENT FILL SHALL BE PLACED IN A SIX-INCH THICK CONTINUOUS LAYER OVER THE ENTIRE LENGTH EACH LIFT SHALL BE PLACED AT OPTIMUM MOISTURE CONTENT AND COMPACTED TO 95% OF MAXIMUM DRY DENSITY AS DETERMINED BY MODIFIED PROCTOR COMPACTION TEST ASTM D1557.
8. STABILIZATION OF POND BERMS, AND ALL SLOPES IN EXCESS OF 3H:1V IN ACCORDANCE WITH "EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL NOTES".
9. SOIL RESTORATION SHALL BE APPLIED TO ALL DISTURBED AREAS THAT WILL REMAIN AS PERVIOUS SURFACES. SOIL RESTORATION SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - 9.A. APPLY 3 INCHES OF COMPOST OVER SUBSOIL.
 - 9.B. TILL COMPOST INTO SUBSOIL TO A DEPTH OF AT LEAST 12 INCHES USING A CAT-MOUNTED RIPPER, TRACTOR MOUNTED DISC, OR TILLER, MIXING AND CIRCULATING AIR AND COMPOST INTO SUB-SOILS.
 - 9.C. ROCK-PICK UNTIL UPLIFTED STONE/ROCK MATERIALS OF FOUR INCHES AND LARGER SIZE ARE CLEANED OFF THE SITE.
 - 9.D. APPLY TOPSOIL TO A DEPTH OF 6 INCHES.
 - 9.E. VEGETATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH LANDSCAPE PLAN.

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1. SITE DISTURBANCE SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE MINIMUM NECESSARY GRADING AND VEGETATION REMOVAL REQUIRED FOR CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE LIMITS OF DISTURBANCE AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS.
2. ORANGE CONSTRUCTION FENCE LOCATIONS AROUND ALL SECTED SYSTEM AREAS SHALL BE STAKED BY A SURVEYOR AND INSTALLATION SHALL BE CONFIRMED BY THE ENGINEER. ALL ORANGE CONSTRUCTION FENCING SHALL BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT CONSTRUCTION TO PROTECT THE SEPTIC SYSTEM. ORANGE CONSTRUCTION FENCING SHALL ONLY BE REMOVED AT TIME ACTUAL CONSTRUCTION OF THE SEPTIC SYSTEM.
3. TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL MEASURES, INCLUDING SILT FENCES, TEMPORARY SWALES, STONE CHECK DAMS, TEMPORARY SEDIMENT BASINS, RIP-RAP PROTECTION SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO GROUND DISTURBANCE FOR GRADING AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED ROADWAY OR DWELLING UNITS.
4. ALL DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE SEEDED AND MULCHED AS SOON AS PRACTICAL, FOLLOWING DISBURTANCE TO STABILIZE BARE SOIL AND PROMOTE THE PROMPT RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF VEGETATION:
 - a. AN ADEQUATE SEEDED SHALL BE PREPARED BY SCARIFYING COMPACTED SOIL AND REMOVING SURFACE DEBRIS AND OBSTACLES.
 - b. DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE RESEEDED TEMPORARILY FOLLOW FOR PERIODS GREATER THAN 30 DAYS SHALL BE SEEDED AT THE FOLLOWING RATE TO PRODUCE TEMPORARY GROUND COVER: 30 LBS PER ACRE (ANNUAL RYE GRASS) FOR WINTER. DURING THE WINTER, USE 100 LBS CERTIFIED "AROSTOOK" WINTER RYE (CEREAL RYE) PER ACRE.
 - c. PERMANENT SEEDED SHALL BE APPLIED ON 4" MIN TOPSOIL AT THE FOLLOWING RATE:
 1. 8 LBS EMPIRE BIRDFOOT TREFOIL OR COMMON WHITE CLOVER PER ACRE PLUS
 2. 20 LBS TALL FESCUE PER ACRE PLUS
 3. 2 LBS REDTOP OR 0.5 LBS RYEGRASS (PERENNIAL) PER ACRE
4. ALL SEEDED SHALL BE PERFORMED USING THE BROADCAST METHOD OR HYDROSEEDING, UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED.
- 4.5. ALL DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE STABILIZED SUBSEQUENT TO SEEDING BY APPLYING 1" OF WHEAT STRAW MULCH PER ACRE. STRAW MULCH SHALL BE ANCHORED BY APPLYING 750 LBS OF WOOD FIBER MULCH PER ACRE WITH A HYDROSEDER, OR TUCKING THE MULCH UNDER SMOOTH DISKS OF OTHER HYDROSEDER. ANCHORING TOOLS TO A DEPTH OF 3". MULCH ANCHORING TOOLS SHALL BE PULLED ACROSS SLOPES ALONG TOPOGRAPHIC CONTOURS.
5. ALL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL MEASURES AND DRAINAGE STRUCTURES SHALL BE INSPECTED FOLLOWING EVERY RAIN EVENT, AND MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS SHALL BE PERFORMED PROMPTLY TO MAINTAIN PROPER FUNCTION. TRAPPED SEDIMENT SHALL BE REMOVED AND DEPOSITED IN A PROTECTED AREA IN A PROPER MANNER WHICH WILL NOT RESULT IN EROSION.
6. TEMPORARY CONTROL MEASURES SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL DISTURBED AREAS ARE PERMANENTLY STABILIZED AND GROUND COVER IS COMPLETELY REESTABLISHED. FOLLOWING STABILIZATION, TEMPORARY MEASURES SHALL BE REMOVED TO AVOID INTERFERENCE WITH DRAINAGE.
7. ALL STORM INLETS TO BE PROTECTED FROM SEDIMENTATION DURING CONSTRUCTION
8. SYNTHETIC OR ORGANIC SOIL STABILIZERS MAY NOT BE USED.
9. MULCH NETTING SUCH AS PAPER, JUTE, EXCELOR, COTTON OR PLASTIC MAY BE USED STAPLE IN PLACE, OVER HAY OR STRAW MULCH. USE A DEGRADABLE NETTING IN AREAS TO BE MOVED.

12. FOR CONSTRUCTION THAT OCCURS DURING WINTER MONTHS (I.E. NOVEMBER 15 - APRIL 1) ADDITIONAL MEASURES SHALL BE TAKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD & SPECIFICATIONS FOR WINTER STABILIZATION SECTION OF THE NEW YORK STATE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR EROSION CONTROL, LATEST VERSION AS PUBLISHED BY THE NYSDCE SUCH AS BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SNOW STORAGE STOCKPILE AREAS
- SNOW STOCKPILES AT CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE SHALL BE OUTSIDE THE STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE TO ENSURE THE FUNCTIONALITY OF THE EROSION CONTROL MEASURE.
- MAINTAIN BUFFERS TO ALL PERMITTER SLOPE FINISHES.
- INSTALL ADDITIONAL SLOPE FENCE AS NECESSARY FOR ANY DISTURBED AREAS ADJACENT TO WATER BODY.
- PROVIDE MAINTENANCE OF ALL DRAINAGE STRUCTURE TO KEEP CLEAR OF SNOW, ICE, DEBRIS, ETC.
- IN AREAS WHERE SOIL DISTURBANCE ACTIVITY HAS TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY CEASED, THE APPLICATION OF SOIL STABILIZATION MEASURES SHALL BE COMPLETED AT THE END OF THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY AND COMPLETED WITHIN THREE (3) DAYS. ROLLED EROSION CONTROL BLANKETS MUST BE USED ON ALL SLOPES 3 HORIZONTAL TO 1 VERTICAL OR STEEPER.
- IF STRAW MULCH ALONE IS USED FOR TEMPORARY STABILIZATION, IT SHALL BE APPLIED AT DOUBLE THE STANDARD RATE OF 2 TONS PER AC, MAKING THE APPLICATION RATE 4 TONS PER AC. OTHER MANUFACTURED MULCHES SHOULD BE APPLIED AT DOUBLE THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATION.
- TO ENSURE PROPER STABILIZATION OF DISTURBED SOIL, IN ADVANCE OF A MELT EVENT, AREAS OF DISTURBED SOIL SHOULD BE STABILIZED AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY UNLESS:
 - WORK WILL RESUME WITHIN 24 HOURS IN THE SAME AREA AND NO PRECIPITATION IS FORECAST OR;
 - THE WORK IS IN DISTURBED AREAS THAT COLLECT AND RETAIN RUNOFF, SUCH AS OPEN TRENCHES, TRENCHES, FOUNDATIONS, EXCAVATIONS, OR WATER MANAGEMENT AREAS.
- USE STONE PATHS TO STABILIZE ACCESS PERIMETERS OF BUILDINGS UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND AREAS WHERE CONSTRUCTION VEHICLE TRAFFIC IS ANTICIPATED. STONE PATHS SHOULD BE A MINIMUM 10 FEET IN WIDTH BUT WIDER AS NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE EQUIPMENT.

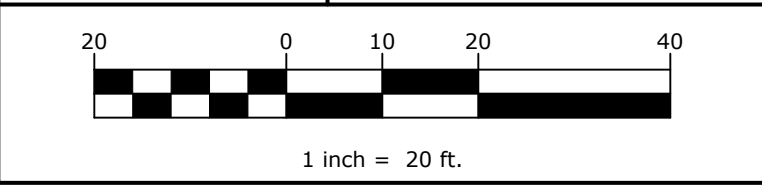

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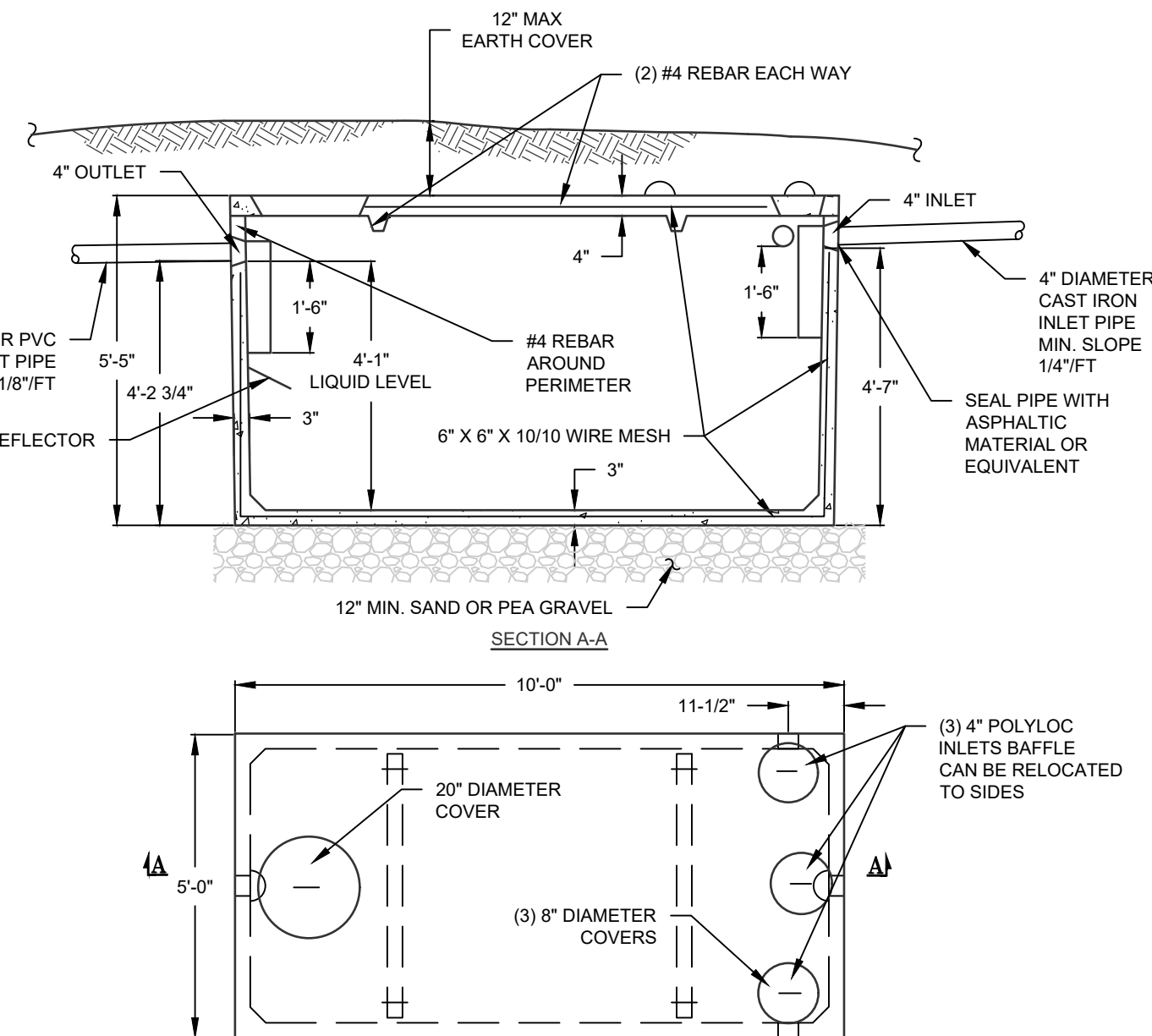
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1. THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PLAN AND GENERALLY ACCEPTED STANDARDS IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF CONSTRUCTION WHICH INCLUDE:

- "APPENDIX 75-A, WASTE TREATMENT - INDIVIDUAL HOUSEHOLD SYSTEMS, NEW YORK STATE SANITARY CODE."
- "NEW YORK STATE DESIGN STANDARDS FOR INTERMEDIATE SIZED WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS," NYSDEC
- "RESIDENTIAL ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS, DESIGN HANDBOOK," NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

3. THIS PLAN IS APPROVED AS MEETING THE APPROPRIATE AND APPLIED TECHNICAL STANDARDS, GUIDELINES, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR ARRANGEMENT OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL, AND TREATMENT AND WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS. THE FOLLOWING IS THE CONDITION OF THIS APPROVAL. A CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DC EHSD SHALL BE DONE TO DETERMINE THAT CONSTRUCTION AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION WAS COMPLETED IN GENERAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND ANY AMENDMENT THEREOF.

5. THE DC EHSD SHALL BE CONTACTED PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE HOME CONSTRUCTION AND/OR ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT FOR A PRE-CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION TO ENSURE THAT THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR WATER SUPPLY AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL ARE COMPLETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND AMENDMENTS THERETO AND GENERALLY ACCEPTED STANDARDS.
6. ALL KNOWN WELLS AND ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS, EXISTING OR APPROVED, LOCATED WITHIN 300 FEET OF THE PROPOSED WELLS AND ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM ARE SHOWN ON THIS PLAN ALONG WITH ANY OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS IN THE AREA THAT MAY AFFECT THE DESIGN AND FUNCTIONAL ABILITY OF THE ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM AND WELL.
7. IF THE TANK IS DELIVERED TO THE SITE IN SECTIONS, THEN IT SHALL BE DEMONSTRATED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE DC EHSD FIELD INSPECTOR AND/OR DESIGN PROFESSIONAL THAT THE TANK IS SEALED, WATERTIGHT AND ACCEPTABLE FOR USE. THIS SHALL REQUIRE, AT A MINIMUM, THE TANK BE FILLED WITH WATER TO OBSERVE IF IT IS IN FACT SEALED, WATERTIGHT AND ACCEPTABLE FOR USE. THE TANK MUST ALSO MEET ANY LOCAL TESTING REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING POSSIBLE ELECTRICAL AND SAFETY STANDARDS.
8. THE PROPOSED WELL AND SERVICE LINES AS SHOWN ON THIS PLAN ARE ACCESSIBLE FOR INSTALLATION AND PLACEMENT.
9. NO CELLAR, FOOTING, FLOOR, GARAGE, OR ROOF DRAINS SHALL BE DISCHARGED INTO THE ONSITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WITHIN 50' OF THE PROPOSED WELL.

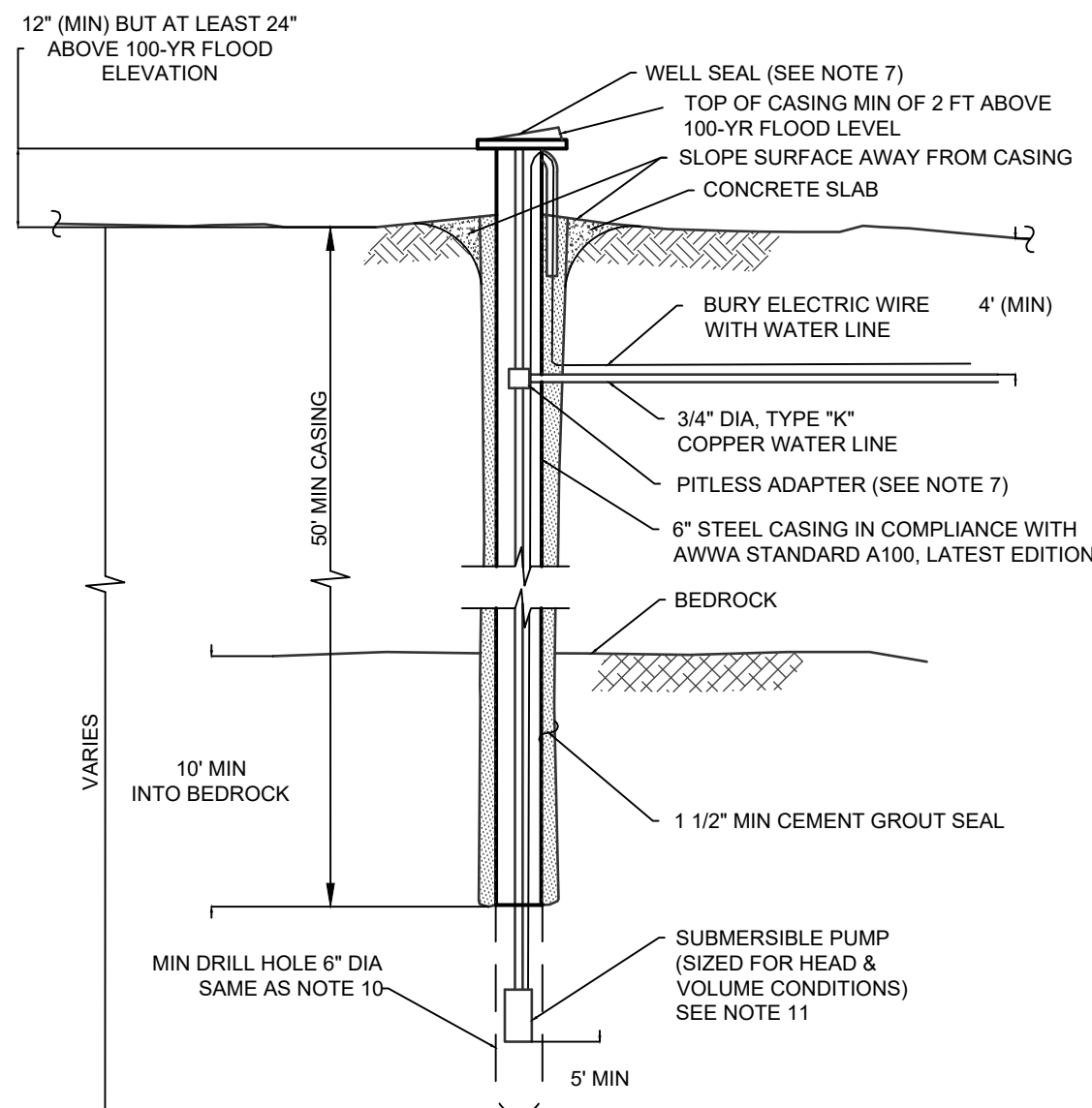

3. PRIOR TO THE PLACEMENT OF FILL, THE AREA OF THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM SHALL BE CLEARED OF DEBRIS, AND ALL BRUSH, TREES, OR OTHER VEGETATION CUT TO A MAXIMUM OF THE VIRGIN GRASS. NO TOPSOIL SHALL BE REMOVED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY INDICATED ON THE PLANS.
